Passionate about both front-end development and back-end design and implementation you'll have worked on applications or large web projects ideally including a CMS (ideally Contentful). Hands on and pragmatic, you'll be able to work with the business to implement great technical outcomes.

You'll have an extensive knowledge of web standards, best practices and full stack architecture and be driven to develop optimised, dynamic solutions. Polished and professional, you'll enjoy sharing ideas, learning and creating experiences that users love.

- Excellent with React and comfortable using nextJs
- Extremely comfortable using git
- Commercial experience with cloud platforms, in our case AWS.
- Years of experience with software testing (unit testing, end-to-end testing and accessibility testing) - we are using Cypress, Browserstack and Axe
- Familiarity with continuous integration and infrastructure as code (we use CircleCl and serverless)
- A willingness to deal with some legacy solutions and code when required.
- Excellent communication and collaboration skills, ability to write clear documentation appropriate for the intended audience
- As a senior developer, a capability for independent thinking and problem solving.
- Looking out for our team identifying opportunities to mentor and help other team members grow their skills.
- Ability to work under pressure & meet deadlines
- A hands-on and pragmatic approach
- Ability to work with the business to implement great technical outcomes.
- Demonstrated ability to work well as part of a team
- The ability to live ReachOut's values and behaviours
